



Student Feedback 2018-19



































































































































Analysis:

1. Academic and Teaching Aspects:

- Attendance: Majority rated excellent (63.5%), indicating high satisfaction.
- Interaction with Teachers: Rated very good (25.4%) and excellent (60.6%), suggesting strong student-teacher engagement.
- Availability of Teachers: 69.2% rated excellent, indicating accessibility of faculty.
- Quality of Teaching: Highly rated with 70.2% excellent feedback.
- Study Materials/Notes: Excellent rating from 67%, showing good availability of resources.
- Career Guidance: 67.6% rated excellent, highlighting effective guidance.
- Syllabus Coverage: 65.7% rated excellent, indicating thorough syllabus completion.
- Internal Assessments: Mostly rated excellent (64.4%), showing satisfaction with assessment methods.
- Theory and Practical Integration: 62.5% excellent, suggesting good integration.

2. Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular Activities:

- Workshops/Projects/Fieldwork: Mixed ratings with 41.6% very good, but
 24.8% average.
- Relationship with Classmates: Highly rated with 61.3% excellent,
- Team Work: 36.5% rated good, indicating room for improvement.

3. Infrastructure and Facilities:

- Security & Safety: 49.8% very good, showing decent safety measures.
- 1CT Facilities: 53% very good, but requires further improvement.
- Physical Infrastructure: Mixed ratings, with 48.6% very good and 29.2% good.
- Library and Laboratory Facilities: 44.1% rated the library as very good, while 40% rated laboratory infrastructure as good.
- Sports Facilities: 51.1% rated good, indicating a need for enhancement.

4. Support Services:

- College Office Staff Support: 43.5% rated excellent, showing good administrative support.
- Redressal and Discipline Committees: High satisfaction with 64.7% and 64.4% excellent ratings respectively.

5. General Amenities:

- Canteen Facilities: Food quality and ambience rated mostly excellent (61.2% and 54.9% respectively).
- Wi-Fi and Internet Facility: 60.6% excellent feedback, but continued monitoring is needed.
- Common Rooms and Drinking Water Facility: Good ratings, but drinking water facility needs improvement.
- Washrooms: Highly satisfactory with 63.8% excellent.
- Cleanliness and Maintenance: 61.3% excellent, but 32.1% rated greenery as average.

6. Cultural and Extracurricular Activities:

- Cultural Events: Rated highly with 48.6% excellent.
- Extracurricular Activities: Mixed ratings with 34.6% excellent and 28.9% good.
- Overall Ratings: Generally positive, with 69.5% rating the overall experience as excellent.



Recommendations:



- Improve Team Work and Sports Facilities: Focus on building stronger teamwork skills and enhancing sports infrastructure.
- Provide more workshop and fieldwork opportunities for students.
- Strengthen ICT and Laboratory Facilities: Invest in better ICT infrastructure and upgrade laboratory facilities.
- Maintain Physical Infrastructure: Regular maintenance and upgrades to physical infrastructure are necessary.
- Focus on Greenery and Cleanliness: Improve greenery around the campus and maintain cleanliness consistently.
- Enhance Extra-Curricular Activities: Increase the variety and frequency of extracurricular activities to engage more students.
- 7. Administrative services could be enhanced.
- Drinking Water Facilities: Ensure more accessible and better-maintained drinking water stations.
- Continuous Feedback Loop: Implement a regular feedback mechanism to continuously address and adapt to students' needs.












































































































































Analysis

The feedback from 272 respondents reveals several strengths and areas for improvement across different facets of college life.

1. High Satisfaction Areas:

- Girls' Common Room: Received the highest number of "Excellent" ratings (200), indicating strong satisfaction.
- Washroom Facilities: Also rated highly with 195 "Excellent" responses.
- Availability of Teachers: Highly rated with 193 "Excellent" responses, reflecting students' satisfaction with their access to faculty.
- Discipline Committee: High satisfaction with 177 "Excellent" responses.
- Wi-Fi and Internet Facility: High satisfaction with 175 "Excellent" responses.
- Attendance: Noted with 172 "Excellent" responses.

2. Moderate Satisfaction Areas:

- Quality of Teaching: Mostly positive feedback with 187 "Excellent" and 69 "Very Good" responses.
- Career Guidance: Similarly positive with 184 "Excellent" and 60 "Very Good" responses.
- Classroom Infrastructure: Appreciated by students with 179 "Excellent" ratings.



- Interaction with Teachers: Well-rated with 161 "Excellent" responses.
- Overall Learning Environment: Positive with a majority rating it "Very Good" (134).

3. Areas Needing Improvement:

- Greenery: Received a lower number of "Excellent" ratings (53) and a higher number of "Good" (127) and "Average" (28) ratings, suggesting a need for improvement.
- Support and Assistance of Staff: 92 "Excellent" ratings but also significant
 "Good" (70) and "Average" (13) responses.
- Laboratory Infrastructure: 57 "Excellent" ratings with a notable number of "Good" (107) and "Average" (5) responses.
- Accessibility of Computers: Mixed feedback with 67 "Excellent", 89 "Very Good", 106 "Good", and 10 "Average" responses.
- Physical Infrastructure: 52 "Excellent" ratings with a high number of "Very Good" (153) and "Good" (58) ratings.
- Sports: Low "Excellent" ratings (39) and high "Good" (147) responses, indicating room for enhancement.
- GEO Lab Staff Support: Lower satisfaction with 35 "Excellent" ratings and higher "Very Good" (137) responses.

Recommendations

- Enhance Greenery: Increase the number of green spaces and improve the maintenance
 of existing ones to elevate the overall campus ambiance.
- Staff Training and Support: Provide additional training for staff to improve their interaction and support with students.
- Laboratory Improvements: Upgrade laboratory infrastructure and ensure consistent availability of necessary equipment and resources.
- Increase Computer Access: Improve the accessibility of computers by expanding lab hours or increasing the number of available units.
- Physical Infrastructure Upgrades: Address the needs for better physical infrastructure to enhance the overall student experience.
- Sports Facilities: Invest in sports facilities and programs to encourage student participation and improve satisfaction in this area.



GEO Lab Support: Focus on improving the support provided by GEO Lab staff through training and resource allocation.

Analysis of the Feedback

Infrastructure Analysis:

- Library and Seminar Facilities: Students generally appreciated the availability of prescribed books in the library and seminar rooms. However, there were suggestions to expand the collection and improve the seating arrangements for better study environments.
- Reading and Common Rooms: Satisfaction was mixed regarding the reading and common rooms. Some students felt they were adequate, while others suggested improvements in comfort and maintenance.
- Internet and Photocopying Facilities: Availability of internet facilities received positive feedback, but there were concerns about the speed and reliability. Similarly, students expressed satisfaction with the photocopying facility but noted occasional issues with availability.
- Classrooms and Laboratories: The condition of classrooms and equipment in labs generally met expectations. However, there were sporadic mentions of maintenance issues that need attention.
- Campus Accessibility: Most students found the campus accessible, though there were suggestions
 for better infrastructure catering to differently abled persons.

Learning Environment Analysis:

- Teaching Quality: Feedback indicated satisfaction with the teaching quality, highlighting the competence and dedication of faculty members.
- Student Support Services: Positive feedback was received regarding the helpfulness of office staff and the effectiveness of grievance redressal mechanisms.
- Extracurricular Activities: Students appreciated the opportunities for extracurricular engagement, though some felt there could be more variety and frequency.


Recommendations:

- Establish a robust system for collecting and acting upon student feedback to continuously improve educational experiences.
- Regularly assess and adjust policies and practices based on feedback to meet evolving student needs.









Students' Feedback Report 2022-23

Analysis of Feedback

The data from the questionnaire were analyzed to calculate the average score for each area assessed. Here are some key points from the feedback:
